# **Course Goals**

The purpose of this course is to provide a guided study through the book of Ezekiel, to give you practice interpreting prophetic material inductively and to consider important issues relevant to the book: its historic context; authorship; prophetic content and major themes. The course will be a useful introduction to the general structure of prophetic writings, as well.

### Instructional Goals

If you *successfully* complete this course you will be able to describe:

- the reasons why Ezekiel was written by Ezekiel
- the historic context of Ezekiel
- the moral and political environment in Judah & amongst the exiles at the time of its writing
- the relationship between Ezekiel's revelation and the covenants of God
- the relationships between Ezekiel's prophecies and those of other prophets.
- features of God's character revealed in the book
- features of human character revealed in the book
- the basic characteristics of prophetic writings

Additionally, successful completion of this course will lead to an appreciation of the glory of God as His and our motivation and thus to a deeper commitment to his service.

# Instructional Procedures and Requirements

Course content will be communicated through lecture and discussion. I will assess your progress toward the course goals through homework.

Homework: At the end of the first four classes you will be given a homework assignment. The reading portion of the assignment will be on the honor system. The rest of the assignment will be collected and evaluated. <u>Do not turn in hand written responses</u> it takes too long to grade.

60% of your final grade will be based on this.

Attendance: Those who show up learn more than those who do not. Therefore, attendance will be taken each week.

40% of your final grade will be based on this.
