Teaching Assignment

Two 15-minute original teachings on assigned passages from Philippians:

- The teachings should be given as to your home group.
- Assume there are non-Christians present.
- You need not teach the entire passage, but you are responsible for proper interpretation and application.
- Limit your teaching notes to one side of an 8" x 5" sheet of paper.
- Bring your own video camera.

Written Assignments

Due the second week:

• Inductive overview of the book of Philippians & "Audience Analysis Worksheet"

Due the week of each teaching:

Teachers

- A copy of the "Homiletic Worksheet" for your teaching
- A copy of your actual teaching notes

Non-teachers

- Participate in giving constructive feedback to each teacher.
- Fill out a "Peer Feedback Sheet" for each teacher and (after the discussion) pass it to the teacher.

Due the week following each teaching:

- A copy of your own evaluation of your teaching, after viewing yourself on video. Don't simply fill out a critique sheet for your teaching. Rather, interact with the feedback from the instructor and other students. How do you agree/disagree with their feedback? What other areas of strength/weakness can you identify? What would you do differently the next time you teach?
- If your second teaching is Week #5, please mail your evaluation to Gary at the Xenos office.
